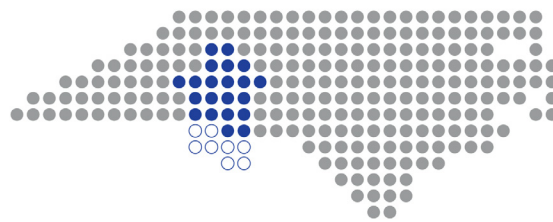


Charlotte-Concord-Gastonia, NC-SC

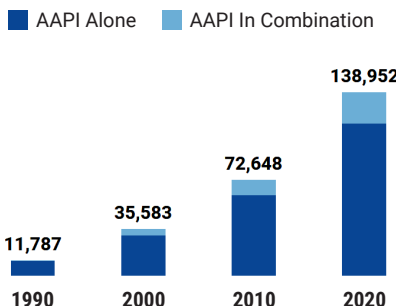

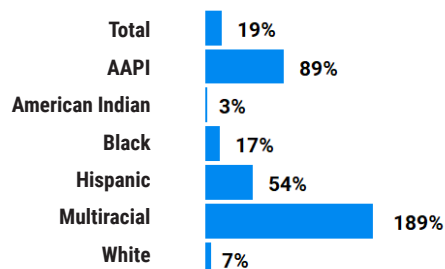

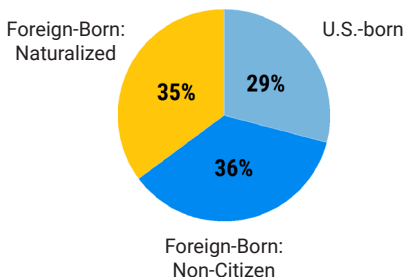

Citizenship Status of Asian and Pacific Islander Population, 2019



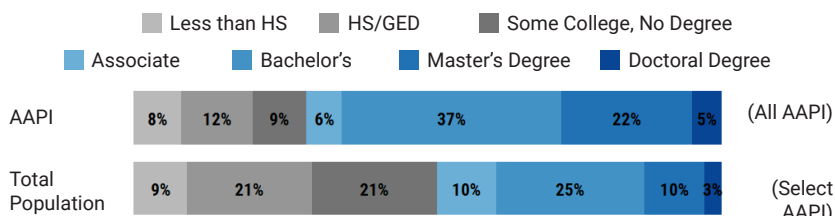
